### **License plate recognition in Whitelist**

In accordance with article 13 of Regulation 679/2016 regarding the protection of personal data and current legislation, it is our responsibility to provide you with some information relating to the treatment of your personal data in the process of the license plate recognition.

#### **Data controller**

The Data Controller is “SDAG SpA a Socio Unico”, headquartered at Stazione Confinaria S. Andrea, 34170 Gorizia (GO). The contact details of the Data Controller can be found on the company website [www.sdag.it](http://www.sdag.it). The Data Controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO) who can be contacted by email at [dpo@sdag.it](mailto:dpo@sdag.it)

#### **Type of data collected and purpose of processing**

An access control with license plate detection is active in the SDAG premises, in order to recognize license plates included in a whitelist and to automatically activate the opening of the barriers.

This automation allows people who usually travel by car to SDAG areas to reduce waiting times while entering and exiting the protected areas. It is necessary to provide personal data (such as the vehicle license plate and the name and contact details of the owner) to activate the processing.

#### **Provision of data and legal basis of processing**

The provision of data is mandatory for the activation of the service; the legal basis of the processing is constituted by contractual obligations for the provision of the service (art. 6 c. 1 letter B of the GDPR) or, where applicable, consent of the interested party (art. 6 c. 1 letter A of the GDPR and art. ).

#### **Data retention**

The data will be stored on the systems until explicitly canceled or until the reason why free access was allowed expires (for example: termination of the employment contract). In any case, the data will be deleted if there are no transits for two years.

#### **Subjects authorized to process**

They will be processed by duly authorized and trained SDAG personnel. The data may be processed on behalf of SDAG by external parties designated as external data controllers pursuant to art. 28 of Regulation 679/2016.

#### **Distribution of data to third parties**

The data will not be transferred to third parties or transferred to non-EU countries.

#### **Rights of the interested party**
